## **ITC Conference Grants**

**ITC Conference Grants** (up to 1000 Euro per applicant) are aimed at supporting PhD students and ECI researchers from Participating **ITC** to attend international science and technology related conferences not specifically organized by the COST Action.

Any e-COST user who is a PhD student or an Early Career Investigator (ECI) and is affiliated with an institution located in an ITC country participating in the Action can apply for an ITC Conference Grant. However, the presentations are mandatory and should be focused on Adhesion GPCRs.

## How to submit an application

Applicants should create a Conference Grant request through the e-COST website: <a href="https://e-services.cost.eu/actions/">https://e-services.cost.eu/actions/</a> using the "<a href="ITC Conference Grants">ITC Conference Grants</a>" link found on the left side of the page, where the following details are to be filled:

- Applicant details
- Conference Grant details (the attendance at the conference must start and end during the same Grant Period (GP). If a GP is not active, the applicant will not be able to submit an application.)
- Bank details
- Financial support
- Supporting documents which also includes the "acceptance letter from the conference organizers".
